Resolution 2017-10 Official Depository

BE IT RESOLVED, that Key Bank is designated an authorized depository of this corporation; and FURTHER RESOLVED, that all drafts, checks, or other instruments or orders for the payment of money drawn against the account or accounts of this corporation with said depository shall be signed by any 2 of the following:

James T. Niwinski, Barry Ping, Tammy Bayes, and Debra Smith; and

FURTHER RESOLVED, that said depository is authorized to place to the credit of the account, or any of the accounts, of this corporation, funds, drafts, checks or other property by whomever delivered to said depository or agent thereof for deposit to the accounts of this corporation, endorsed with the name of this corporation, by rubber stamp, facsimile, mechanical, manual, or other signature (and any such endorsement by whomever affixed shall be the endorsement of this corporation), or otherwise endorsed, or unendorsed, provided that if any such item shall bear, or be accompanied by, directions (by whomever made) for deposit to specific account, then such deposit shall be to the credit of such specific account: and

FURTHER RESOLVED, that said depository is hereby directed to accept, and/or pay and/or apply any draft, check, instrument or order for the payment of money, or any proceeds thereof, drawn on such account or accounts when signed as required by these resolutions by manual, rubber stamp, facsimile, or other mechanical signature (by whomever affixed) without limit as to amount, without inquiry, and without regard to the disposition of any such item or any proceeds thereof. Further, said depository shall not be liable in connection therewith notwithstanding that such item may be payable to the order of a person whose signature appears thereon or of any other officer or officers, agent or agents of this corporation, or such items or any proceeds thereof may be used or disposed of for the personal credit or account of any such person or persons, officer or officers, agent or agents with the depository or otherwise.

Resolution 2017-11 KeyBank Credit Authorization

Whereas, the Governing Body has determined that it is in the best interest of the Village of Sloan to obtain and establish a corporate credit card program from KeyBank, which program may consist of one or more credit card accounts with one or more authorized users being provided an access device in the form of credit cards for such account, provided that the maximum amount of revolving credit extended under such program will not exceed \$8,000.00, and

Whereas, the Governing Body has reviewed the documentation necessary to maintain the credit card program from KeyBank including the Business Credit Card Application, the Cardmember Agreement, and any other documentation and disclosures provided by KeyBank to the Village of Sloan, and Whereas, the Governing Body has determined that the credit card program is hereby authorized; is budgeted for; and is an appropriate expenditure for the Village of Sloan, Now Therefore Be It Resolved, the Governing Body does hereby authorize the Village of Sloan (1) to apply to KeyBank to establish the program, (2) to enter into the program with KeyBank where such program is a revolving credit arrangement with no set termination date, bearing the interest rates, fees and other terms as set forth in the documentation, and which rates, fees and other terms are subject to change in accordance with the provisions of the documentation, and (3) to maintain the program in accordance with the documentation provided that the maximum amount of credit to be extended under the program shall not exceed the maximum credit limit of \$8,000.00 and, further

Resolved, the Governing Body represents there are no provisions of any law, or any certificate of incorporation, charter or bylaws, or any agreement of any kind binding upon the Village of Sloan that prohibit the entering into and performing its obligations under the documentation, which documentation shall constitute binding obligation of the Village of Sloan and, further Resolved, the Governing Body recognizes that KeyBank is the issuer of the credit card accounts established under the program and that such accounts will be opened in the name of the Village of Sloan. The Governing Body hereby authorizes the Mayor and Deputy Mayor to (1) execute and deliver all necessary applications, instruments, agreements, schedules, certificates and directions as may be required, all of which shall become part of the documentation (2) to open and close accounts, and (3) to further designate other authorized representatives to provide day-to-day operational instruction and direction to KeyBank for maintenance of the program, such operational instruction to include the ability to designate new authorized users of credit cards under the program, to cancel authorized users from the program, to adjust the spend limit assigned to an authorized user, among other things. Each of the persons whose signature is attached to this certification is a duly elected, qualified and acting officer of the Village of Sloan holding the office or offices set forth and each of the officers is authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of the Village of Sloan, each document to which the Village is a party and all other agreements, documents and certificates to be delivered by

the Village of Sloan pursuant thereto.
